Two Local Non-Profits Working Together for Your Community



PCCF is joining forces with Touched By Cancer to present the first Clays for the Community. This event is a clay target shooting sport and differs from skeet or trap shooting in that it involves shooting clay targets from various locations launched at different velocities and angles. Participants will get 60 clay targets at 15 stations with four shots at each station.

Experience is not necessary. The event begins with safety instructors providing introductory lessons, demonstrating safe and responsible gun handling and answering shooting questions. This event is designed so that even if you are a novice, you can come and enjoy it. Those who do not have a shot gun will be provided with one for the event and everyone will be provided with eye and ear protection. While the course is walkable, golf carts will be available to transport those who would rather ride.

HOW CAN I ESTABLISH A FUND?

There are six different types of funds (with a minimum donation of \$10,000) available to Donors. They are as follows:

UNRESTRICTED FUNDS

Have no external restriction on their use or purpose, help solve future problems, and support grant making projects.

AGENCY ENDOWED FUNDS

Created by a need for the Community Foundation to serve as a fiscal agent for another 501 (c)(3) organization to provide an ongoing source of income for the organization.

FIELD OF INTEREST FUNDS

Created to support a broad area of interest such as youth, education, or the arts.

DESIGNATED FUNDS

Support specific charitable organization identified by the donor.

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

Designated for any level of education, from preschool to post-graduate work, or particular field of study.

ADMINISTRATIVE FUND

Offers you an opportunity to provide support to the ongoing operation of the Pickaway County Community Foundation.
