Scholarship Guidelines

Scholarship Background

The Mona and Scott Allen Scholarship Fund has been established to assist students who plan to continue their education in college or vocational school programs.

Eligibility Criteria

- Candidate must be a graduating high school senior from a Pickaway County High School, or a previous recipient of this scholarship.
- Candidate must have at least a 3.0 grade point average.
- Candidate should have a financial need for the scholarship award.
- Candidate should be involved with their community.

Selection Criteria

- 40% Financial Need
- 25% Academic Potential
- 25% Character
- 10% Community Service and Leadership Potential

Selection Committee

- This scholarship will be awarded by the Pickaway County Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee.

Scholarship Renewal

- This scholarship is nonrenewable. However, previous recipient may reapply as long as they meet the eligibility requirements. However, scholarship is not a guaranteed award.

Award Amount

- \$2,000

Payment Distribution

- This scholarship may be used for tuition, books, and other academic fees. The scholarship must not displace any institutional aid.

Application Requirements

- Privacy Declaration
- Notification of Change of Plans Agreement
- Personal Information and Photo Release
- Evaluation Form
- Letter of Recommendation
- Student Aid Report (SAR) from FASFA
- To be determined.
- Pickaway County Community Foundation will send applications to the eligible high schools for distribution for the upcoming academic year. Applications will also be made available on the Pickaway County Community Foundation website and in the office.
- Candidates complete the paper application by the deadline.
- After the deadline, the Pickaway County Community Foundation reviews complete applications for eligibility.
- The Foundation sets up the selection committee meeting.

Deadline

- April 19, 2022

Application and Award Process

- Finalist are chosen by the selection committee.
- Interviews of the finalist take place.
- The Foundation sends denial letters to those who did not receive the scholarship.
- The Foundation sends award letters to recipients that include an explanation of the payment request process and the proof of enrollment form.
- Once proof of enrollment has been received by the Foundation, a check will be sent to the recipient's educational institution.
