



PCCF Scholarships Awarded

The Pickaway County Community Foundation has been fortunate to be able to award the youth of Pickaway County with several scholarships thanks to our generous donors. These scholarships are intended to offset college expenses and ensure success in their future endeavors.

The Mona and Scott Allen Scholarship

The Mona and Scott Allen Scholarship Fund was established to assist students who plan to continue their education beyond high school and is awarded annually by the PCCF. This year, the Mona and Scott Allen Scholarship was awarded to Rain Hoops, a graduate of Logan Elm High School who resides in Circleville, Ohio. Her current plan is to attend Ohio University — Chillicothe and major in either social work or health services.



The Alvarez Family Scholarship for Health Care Careers

The Alvarez Family Scholarship for Health Care Careers is awarded in memory of Carlos Barriere Alvarez, MD, and Jacqueline Shelton Alvarez by their family. This scholarship provides financial aid to those pursuing a career in a healthcare or a social service field. This year, the Alvarez Family Scholarship for Health Care Careers was awarded to Andrew Dean, a graduate of Teays Valley High School who resides in Ashville, Ohio. His current plan is to attend Ohio University — Athens and major in biology on the pre-med track.

Joshua Green Memorial Scholarship

The Joshua Green Memorial Scholarship is awarded in memory of Joshua Green, a graduate of Westfall High School. The award goes to a student at Westfall High School who has been active in athletics during their high school career. This year, the Joshua Green Memorial Scholarship was awarded to Grace Johnson, a graduate of Westfall High School who resides in Circleville, Ohio. Her current plan is to attend Cedarville University and major in nursing.

PCCF Issues \$39,000 in Grants During Second Quarter

The Pickaway County Community Foundation was once again able to facilitate in-person grant presentations this quarter. The purpose of these presentations is to provide donors with an in-depth understanding of what grant applicants intend to do with donations. Subsequently, \$39,000 in grants were able to be presented by PCCF during the second quarter of the year.



Compassion Furniture Bank

Compassion Furniture Bank's Bed Project received \$6,500 worth of grant awards. The money was a culmination of donations from the PCCF, the Scott and Mona Family Fund, and the Sutton Family Fund of the PCCF. The goal with these awards is to provide beds and mattresses to both families and individuals of Pickaway County struggling to furnish their homes due to adversity and/or poverty.

Pickaway County Pathways Program

The Pickaway County Pathways Program received \$3,500 in grant allocations this quarter. This donation came from the PCCF, the Scott and Mona Family Fund, and the Sutton Family Fund of PCCF. They provide youth in Pickaway County with a culinary arts program that offers a creative learning space. This allows youth to focus on academic and social emotional skills in a modified learning environment.

American Red Cross of South-Central Ohio

The American Red Cross of South-Central Ohio plans to utilize their \$2,000 in grant allocations from the PCCF's Well Being Fund to raise awareness of the blood donation's role in fighting cancer. They plan to host multiple drives to encourage participation in our community.

Uptown Circleville

Uptown Circleville was awarded \$14,000 for a revitalization project. The funds will be used to erect a town clock in order to inspire residents and tourists to invest their time into Circleville. The clock may also serve as a marketing tool for local businesses to attract customers.

The Pickleball Association

The Pickleball Association plans to utilize their \$2,000 in grant awards for the construction of two new pickleball courts to be located at Barthelmas Park, which is located at 830 Kingston Pike, Circleville. They hope the construction will inspire physical activity for all ages.

Ronald McDonald House of Charities

Ronald McDonald House of Charities was the recipient of \$3,000 in grant funds from PCCF's Well Being Fund, for their Helping Hands Program. Their mission is to support programs that increase the health and well-being of children and their families.

Pickaway County Community Action

Pickaway County Community Action received \$7,000 in additional support for their Wheels to Work program. The funds will assist income-eligible applicants enrolled, employed, or in school to earn money to purchase a vehicle. Participants must complete budgeting and financial literacy programming as part of the program.



PCCF at the Fair



The PCCF Agriculture Fund provided fair attendees with breakfast from Chris's Cakes on Saturday, June 25 prior to the livestock sale. This breakfast consisted of pancakes made freshly in front of attendees and flipped onto their plates from afar. Approximately 225 Pickaway County Fair attendees were served.

PCCF is utilizing the Food Insecurities Fund, a portion of which was allocated through American Recovery Funds, to purchase steers at the Pickaway County Fair. The foundation provided a premium bid

of \$1.45 per pound for the youth to support their hard work for the long-term commitment that a steer project requires. The steers were delivered to a local processing facility and the hamburger will be given to the Pickaway County food pantries for distribution.



The Youth Advisory Council (YAC) had the opportunity to do an activity for the Cloverbuds at the fair this year! YAC was gifted COSI kits from the Inspiration Station, allowing them to do nature-themed activities with the Cloverbuds. The kids learned about animal adaptation and the food chain.

The Youth Advisory Council is a student-led council made up of students from all four Pickaway County school districts; their mission is to promote community enrichment in Pickaway County through philanthropic activities such as grantmaking, service planning, and community-based partnerships.
